

Dorm Worker (Ages 21 and up)

General Duties

- o Handle any tasks delegated by the Dorm Parents
- o Ensure cleanliness of your assigned rooms/rows
- o No eating food in the dorms
- o Escalate disciplinary issues to the Dorm Parents but feel free to handle what you can
- o Assist during recreation time (crafts, gym activities, water days, Hoopla, etc...)
- o You will be assigned a group of campers you will be responsible for the entire week – get to know them and any specific needs they may have (ex: medication, allergies, etc....) *ALL medications must be turned into the Nurse/Medic*
- o Assist in the cafeteria – help with the lines, pick up trash & helping campers find a place to sit at the tables (inside and outside)

Daily Duties

- o Worship and pray with campers each service
- o Ensure campers are up and out of the dorms in time for morning and afternoon services
- o Ensure rooms/rows are clean and beds/surrounding areas are tidy prior to morning service and lights out
- o Assist Dorm Parents with ensuring campers are in bed by lights out
- o Assist with serving meals as scheduled
- o Assist with cleaning bathrooms/dorms – All Dorm Workers will be assigned cleaning assignments throughout the week
- o Assist in the shower line – the lines can be VERY long

Thursday Night Duties

- Ensure each camper in your assigned rooms/rows have packed their things for dismissal on Friday morning

Friday Morning Duties

- Ensure camper's personal items are outside before campers go to breakfast (in the case of bad weather, campers may leave their personal items in the dorms)
- Take all trash from the dorms to the dumpster

What do I need to pack???

- Clothes for church services
- Toiletries and shower shoes
- Clothes to clean in – (bleach is used)
- Clothes to get wet in (for helping with water day)
- Rain boots and umbrella
- Comfortable shoes
- Bedding
- Wacky clothes – if you choose to participate in the Wacky Tacky parade
- Bring some cash for offerings and for snack purchases in the snack shack

A few tips:

Bro. Hermis will have a meeting every morning to go over the day's events – please make sure you are in attendance. These meetings are important – the schedule for the day is given and other important info from the Dorm Parents.

The TEEN WORKERS have a lot of responsibility – please be kind and encourage/pray with them as well.

Some of these campers are first timers, don't have the Holy Ghost, and may be missing home – be patient, it gets better towards the end of the week, and YES!!! we want them to receive the Holy Ghost!!

The campers have the opportunity each day to sign up for Singspiration, Sticks, Sign Team and Drama (these spots are limited) ... everyone can be in the choir!

Dorm Workers eat meals at the same time as the campers – plan your time wisely – get through the line early so you can assist with clean up – eat later so you can assist with the line.

Meet some new friends and enjoy the week – it goes by so fast and these kids will remember your impact!
